Many people with learning disabilities or difficulties support and care for others. This might be your partner, mum, dad, friend or child.

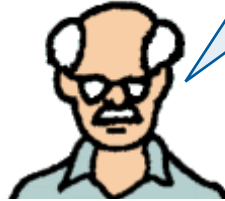
BUT we are often not seen as carers and often don't think of ourselves as carers.
